Schedule of Novice Classes and the Unrung Section

Novice Classes

Novice Classes are open to all pet rabbits. Classes 1 to 25 are open to SARA members and non-members alike. Classes 26 & 27 are for SARA members only. "Juniors" are persons under 15 years of age and "Seniors" 15 years and older.

Use the table below to select classes you and your bunny want to enter, then register bunny's name and yours at the judging table and pay your fees. Each class has a \$2.00 entry fee. When two rabbits are required to enter a class e.g. Most Unusual Pair, the total fee payable is \$2.00. Once registered; when your class is called simply bring your rabbit up to the judging table and place on a mat. Please note, some classes may not be offered or "scratched" on show day and entry fees will be refunded. Good luck!

Unrung Section

Pure bred rabbits not wearing identification leg rings may enter the Unrung Section and be judged in the breed sections as per the following table. The rabbit judged best in their Section goes on to be judged for the prize of either Runner Up or Best Unrung in Show. Entry fee is a flat rate \$2 per rabbit.

Unrung Fur	British Giant, Californian, New Zealand, Chinchilla, Satin or any other fur variety.	Best Unrung Fur
Unrung Rex	Standard Rex and Mini Rex.	Best Unrung Rex
		Runner Up & Best Unrung in Show

Additional Notes:

1. Individual breed classes will only be available on the day if 3 or more rabbits of the same breed are exhibited. When there are less than 3, all these rabbits will be grouped in the All Other Varieties (AOV) class.
2. Additional age classes may apply pending breed entry numbers.
3. All SARA judges (including trainee) will follow the corresponding **breed** standard when judging.
